Families who find themselves experiencing financial hardship can apply for assistance.

The College aims to provide students with exemplary educational opportunities that reflect best practice in teaching and learning. We are very committed to supporting all families seeking the faith-based education that our College offers. In instances where families experience financial hardship, the College will provide parents with assistance in meeting their obligations to the College.

The College will request that a family complete a Financial Assistance Form. The primary purpose of the collection of the information contained in the Financial Assistance Form is to allow the College to assess the level of fee relief available to the family.

- Fee relief, if granted, is applicable for a specific school year and will be reviewed on an annual basis
- The basis of fee relief is to allow the attendance at Kilbreda College of a girl (or girls) whose family finances might otherwise preclude her attendance. There are a limited number of fee relief packages available in any given year.
- Fee relief is granted for a proportion of the Tuition Fees only. It does not cover other charges that may be levied from time to time including but not limited to: Optional Excursions, Books, Uniforms and Instrumental Charges.
- Documentary evidence in support of your application is essential. Applications will not be assessed if they are not accompanied by the required documents.
- You may be required to attend an interview with the Business Manager.
