
French Fries Day 13th of July

VANILLA ICE-CREAM DAY 23RD OF JULY




The very first ice-cream predates to 200bc in ancient China, a concoction of rice and milk.

Q: Jim has 125 lollipops. He eats 76 of them. What does he have now?













WORLD TOFUDAY 26TH OF JULY
