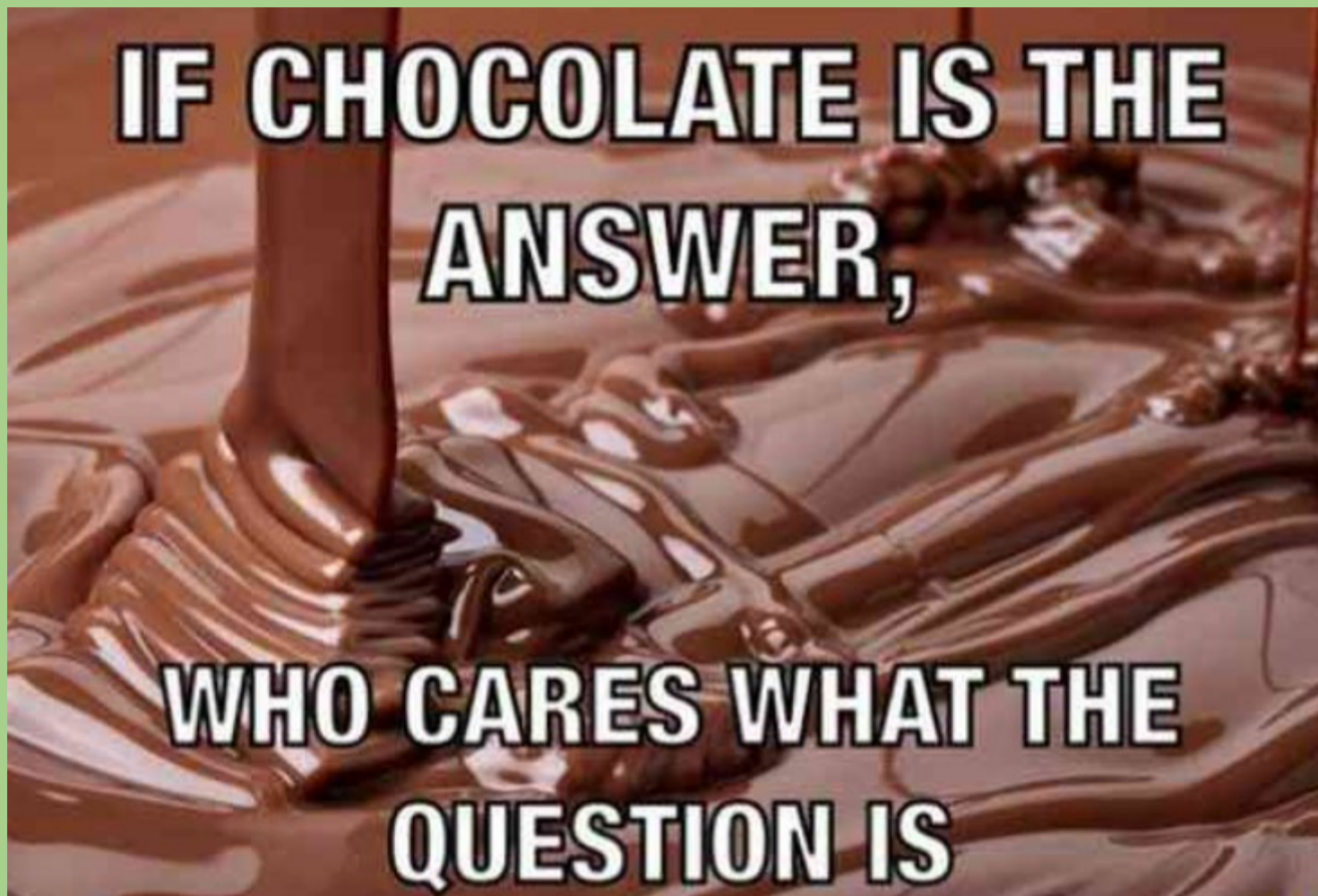
**The first mention of French Fries dates to 1775 in a Parisian book**

**Sour candy first came out in 1954, it quickly grew in popularity due to its mouth numbing properties.**

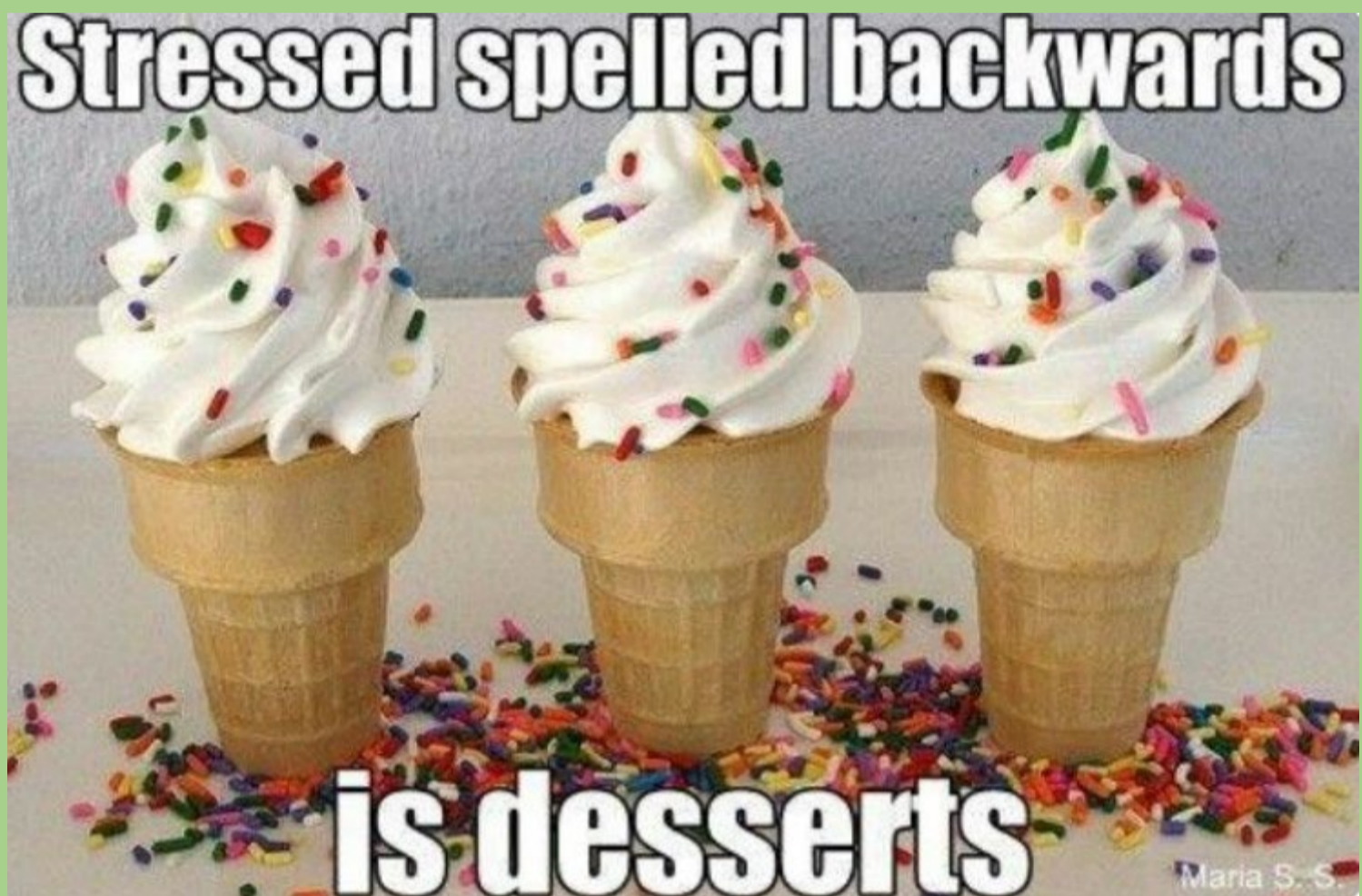
**The tradition of Sour Candy Day was founded by an American company to encourage people to sample their products.**

**23<sup>RD</sup> OF JULY**



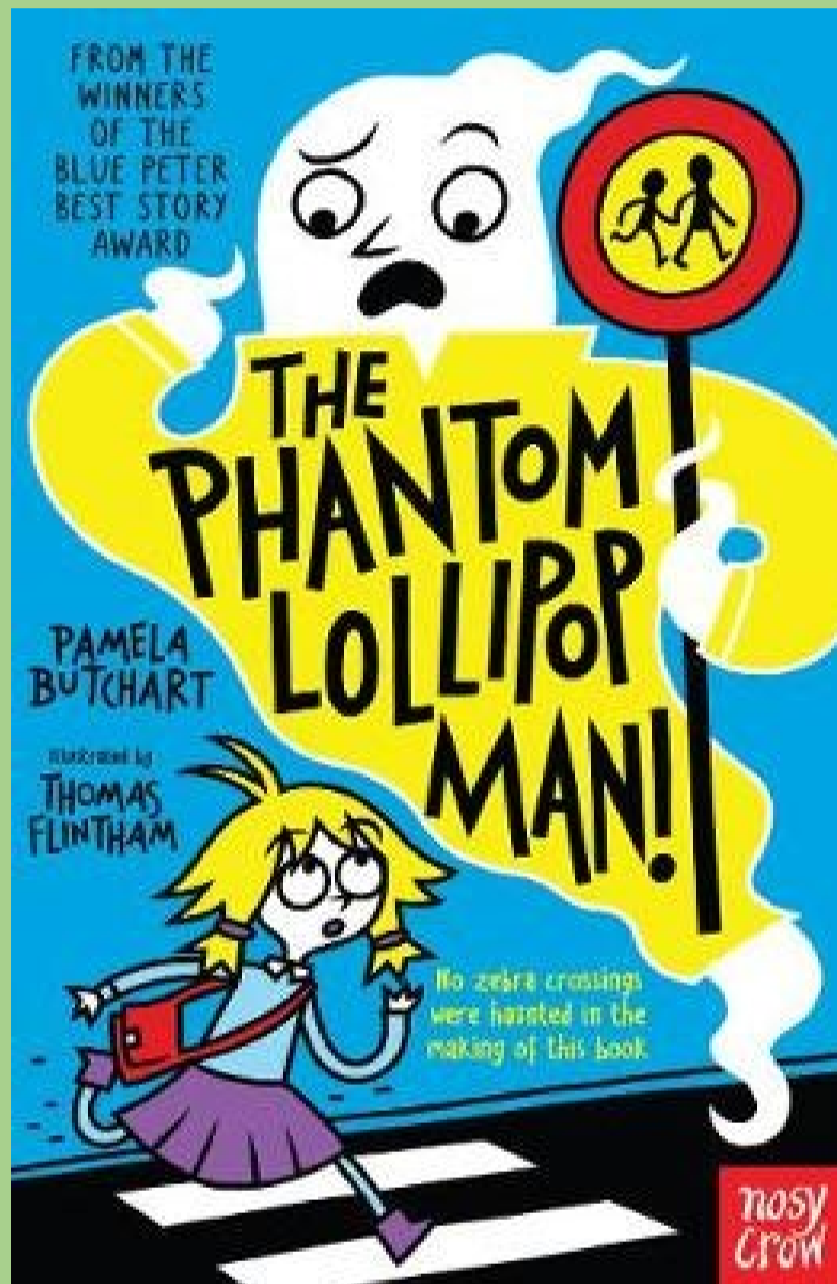
**The very first ice-cream predates to 200bc in ancient China, a concoction of rice and milk.**

Day 20<sup>th</sup> of July



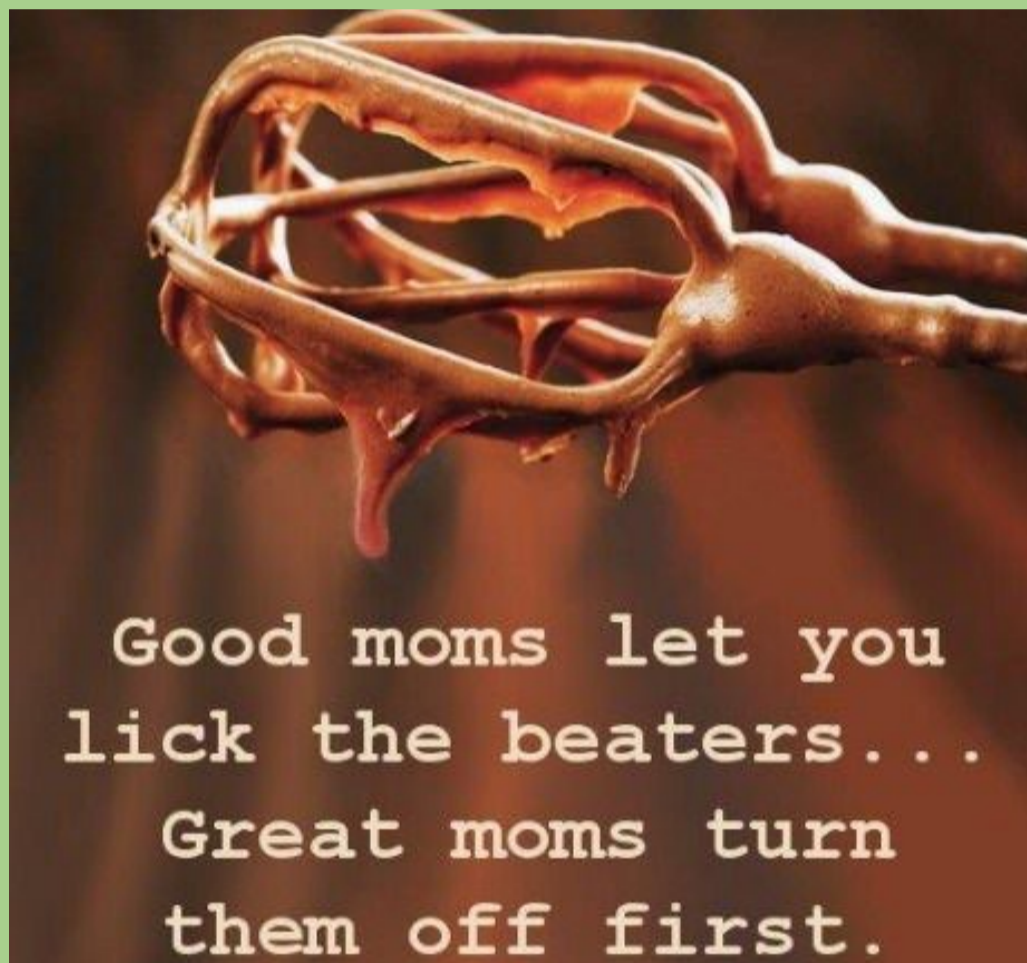
