

# PERFORMING ARTS

The learning and teaching program at Kilbreda College is both dynamic and innovative, catering for the students' spiritual, academic, social, emotional and physical development. Students are challenged to be creative, critical and reflective thinkers and to develop a broad and transferable skill set. Opportunities for both independent and collaborative learning are provided and contemporary technologies are integrated throughout the learning and teaching program.

The College has a vibrant Performing Arts curriculum that offers students the opportunity to explore, experience and communicate their creative expression through Drama, Music and Dance. As well as being studied at the junior levels Drama, Music and Dance are subjects offered in VCE level where our students consistently excel and feature at *Top Acts* and *Top Class* concerts.

Many excursions to performances, theatres and incursions featuring dancers, musicians and theatre groups take place throughout the year.

In addition to the Performing Arts Curriculum, there are extensive opportunities for students to be involved in the cocurricular program, which include productions in conjunction with St Bede's College.

In Music, students can participate in bands, orchestras, ensembles and the choirs. Private and small group music tuition is also available for many instruments. The instrumental music tutors are highly experienced musicians and teachers.

In Dance, students can join the Kilbreda Dance Company (KDC), student led dance teams that perform at school functions, assemblies and competitions.

In Drama, students can join the Drama Club. Meeting once a week, the club gives students of all levels of experience the chance to increase their confidence and improve their drama skills.

### **Performing Arts Curriculum**

### **Performing Arts Week**

A dedicated week planned by Performing Arts staff along with the Performing Arts student leaders, that highlights the Learning Area and encourages participation from all students in the College. #### Kilbreda Festival

An annual Performing Arts Eisteddfod celebrating individual and group performances in Voice, Instrumental Music, Drama and Dance. Students will compete in heats at lunchtime and the finalists will perform in a Gala Evening in front of the College Community. Students will also gain an opportunity to perform in front of their friends and family and judges from the Performing Arts Industry will provide feedback to the students.

#### **Music Concerts**

The College concerts are celebrations of Dance and Music and take place multiple times a year including a festive Christmas concert.

#### **Year 7 Instrumental Information Evening**

This evening allows instruments and ensembles to be showcased to students and families.
