# We're busy removing level crossings

Victoria's Big Build is making the Frankston Line level crossing free by removing all 27 of the dangerous and congested level crossings by 2029. We're building 17 new stations, improving safety, reducing congestion and allowing more trains to run more often.

We're removing the level crossing at Warrigal Road, Mentone and Parkers Road, Parkdale by building a rail bridge over the road and a new Parkdale Station with modern and accessible facilities for passengers. We're creating new community open space including planting new trees and greenery, community gathering places as well as sporting and recreational facilities for the community to enjoy.

Removing these crossings will change how locals live, work and travel. Journeys on the Frankston Line will be faster and local roads safer.

## Road disruptions and level crossing closures

The Warrigal Road level crossing will close from **9pm Wednesday 4 October to 11.30pm Saturday 21 October.** 

The Parkers Road level crossing will close from 12am Sunday 22 October to 12am Saturday 4 November.

### Parkdale Station shuttle bus

Parkdale Station will close from 11.30pm Saturday 21 October to mid-2024. During this time, Frankston Line trains will run express through Parkdale Station.

From Saturday 4 November to mid-2024, a shuttle bus will run as a loop between Mentone, Parkdale and Mordialloc stations to connect you to trains.

There will be additional stops along Como Parade East and Como Parade West in Parkdale and Mentone to help you move around the station area.

### Pedestrian access changes

There will be changes to the way you move around Parkdale Station precinct throughout October and November.

The pedestrian crossings will be closed at times along the train line between Warrigal Road and Parkers Road, changing the way you move around the station precinct.
