
Includes accommodation, all meals, transport and guided walks to key places in the Far North.

- Daily Guided Walks: Explore iconic Wet Tropics
 destinations including Fitzroy Island, Mossman Gorge in
 the Daintree National Park, The Atherton Tablelands,
 Northern Beaches, Glacier Rock Lookout, and Barron River
 Gorge. Daily walks average Grade 3 (trails may have steep
 hill sections, rough surfaces and natural steps.)
- **Spiritual Reflection:** Engage in meaningful discussions and guided reflections.
- Healthy, simple living within Earth's limits: mindful eating of abundant, fresh, seasonal, local, and ethically sourced meals.
